VSO LED Beacon

Dorgard

This is an acoustic retainer that is suitable for such applications as offices, care homes and hotels. Dorgard's wire-free construction allows for an easy installation period of under 5 minutes, simply affix the Dorgard to your fire door by use of 4 screws. All the power the Dorgard requires is the use of 2 C-size batteries within its self contained unit.

After "hearing" a fire alarm level of 65 decibels or over for at least 14 seconds the door will then be released to close. The Dorgard is BS EN 1155:1997 approved and also complies with the DDA - improving access for wheelchair users. To order this product please quote: 302-074. Deafgard

Deafgard is fire alarm technology for the deaf and the hard of hearing. Constructed with both a high intensity strobe and vibrate pillow-pad, the Deafgard is designed to automatically activate via the use of the same acoustic technology as the Dorgard.

Deafgard works by being kept on a bedside table and placing the vibrating pad under the users pillow. Upon the alarm being triggered the pad vibrates to wake the sleeper and the LCD initiates providing a flashing strobe to give a form of visual indication also, ensuring the DDA is complied with. Dorgard X

Dorgard X consists of 2 parts, the Receiver and Transmitter. It relies on the Transmitter being situated next to a fire alarm and upon the event of a fire alarm sounding, transmits radio signals to any number of Receivers that are positioned within a 100 metre range of the Transmitter. When the radio signal reaches the Receiver, it then acts in the same way the Dorgard does, and releases the fire door.

Again complying with BS EN 1155, the use of radio transmissions make the Dorgard X ideal for applications where there might be a high degree of noise, including bars, restaurants and public areas.
